028/07 Proposed Tennis Courts - Kern Roberts had reported to the Chairman that three more residents had expressed an interest in the tennis club and a meeting would shortly take place. Meeting with SCDC Planning Department – 17 September 2013 – Awaiting response re. Construction of garage 33 Church Street. Cllr Martin reported that Kate Wood, who had been dealing with this query had now left SCDC without giving a response, as had the case officer James Darcy. He will continue to seek an answer.

Notification of a planning application (S/2465/13/FL) for a Two-storey Rear Extension at 18 Bird's Close had been received too late to go on the Agenda and copies of the plans had not been received. An application for an extension to our next meeting on 15 January was not acceptable by SCDC and they have requested a reply before 14th January 2014. Some Councillors had been able to review the plans on line and reported on the proposals and how these differed from those previously submitted (which had been supported by the Parish Council). In the exceptional circumstances forced upon the Parish Council by SCDC, Councillors decided after discussion that it was the recommendation of the Parish Council to SCDC that the application be: Approved

It had been noted that a period of 3 weeks had elapsed from the period of registration to the date the application was available on SCDC's website, and it was agreed that the Parish Council would complain about the delay.

278/13 Reports from Councillors:

<u>Susan Clew</u> reported that she had been asked why the Parish Council turn down so many planning applications. It was felt that many did not understand the workings of planning applications and the Chairman would put together an explanation which could go in Icene and on the website. **Action: TS**<u>Terry Sadler</u> had contacted Camilla Haggett (CCC) regarding the proposed closure to vehicles of the Mill Lane level crossing. It appears that in 1990 the crossing was down graded to a bridleway. The Chairman will circulate an e-mail from CCC to Councillors and the item will be put on the Agenda next month.
